There will be two divisions: (1) 8<sup>th</sup> grade and under & (2) 9<sup>th</sup> grade to 18. Then further divided within each to comprise of boys and girls separately. \*\*\*USBC Youth membership is available to anyone having not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to August 1<sup>st</sup> of the current bowling season and have maintained compliance with **USBC Youth Rule 400**\*\*\*

There will be two events: Doubles and Singles. All entries will be entered into both handicap and scratch. Two Shifts will be available: (9:30 A.M or 1:30 P.M) Any event can be bowled at any shift of choice.

8<sup>th</sup> Grade and under:

- Doubles: 6 Baker games; Singles: 3 games
  - \$25/event (\$9 lineage, \$12 scholarship, \$4 admin.)

9<sup>th</sup> Grade to age 18

- Doubles: 8 baker games; Singles: 4 games
  - \$35/event (\$12 lineage, \$19 scholarship, \$4 admin.)

\*\*Bowlers may enter each event twice. For doubles; you must change partners.

\*\* Scholarships awarded to 1/5 entries. The oil pattern for this event will be a Modified House

## RULES

1. All Current USBC Youth Members shall be permitted to bowl in this tournament.
2. This tournament is a scratch and handicap tournament. Bowlers can cash once in handicap and once in scratch . Handicap will be based on 70% of 200. Bowlers must show proof of average from bowl.com 2022-2023 highest average. In the event a bowler doesn't have a bowl.com average, they can use their most recent USBC certified league standing sheet. The bowler must have completed a minimum of 9 games. Please mail in the standing sheets with your entry form. High School average will only be accepted if certified through a high school certification.
3. **Tournament check-in:** all entrants must check in at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled starting time. **No walks ins allowed.**
4. Awards will be published within 30 days of the completion of the tournament on gclubsonline.com.
5. Multiple entries: a bowler can bowl two times per event, but for doubles, you must change partners.
6. Substitutions/tardy bowlers: substitutions can be made for DOUBLES. Tardy bowlers may begin bowling in the frame being bowled at the time they arrive. However, they will receive a zero (0) for every frame missed. There will be no score given for vacant bowlers.
7. No electronic devices are allowed in the bowlers' area (i.e., cell phones, tablets, earbuds, etc.)
8. **Dress Code/Behavior:** Bowlers participating in this tournament will abide by the following dress code. Tournament directors will determine if bowler's attire is within guidelines. Bowlers will not be permitted to bowl if the following guidelines are not met:
  - a. Dress code for this event will be pants, skorts (girls) skirts (girls), and a collared shirt or bowling jersey.
  - b. No Jeans, leggings, basketball shorts, t-shirts, or hats are permitted during the event.
  - c. Apparel or bowling equipment that depicts alcohol, tobacco, gambling, or inappropriate language/gestures will not be allowed.
  - d. Pants must be worn at waist level. Shorts/skorts/skirts must be no shorter than the end of the fingertips.
  - e. Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language by bowlers or spectators is prohibited. Bowler disqualification will occur after one warning. spectators will be asked to leave the bowling center.
9. All scores should be verified by participants and all errors called to the attention of a tournament director immediately. All scores will be checked by the tournament director.
10. NO REFUNDS will be given after the entry has been processed for the tournament.
11. USBC rules will govern all bowling. Tournament directors will enforce all rules. The directors have the authority to disqualify any bowler for violating the above stated rules or any USBC rules during the course of bowling this tournament.
12. Tournament directors have the right to rerate averages at their discretion.
13. Lower division bowlers have the option to bowl in the upper division. It must be declared before the start of the tournament.
14. Alcohol can only be consumed by spectators of legal age in a separate room OR No alcohol will be sold during the tournament. No Smoking/vaping during the tournament. Any bowler vaping/smoking will be disqualified.
